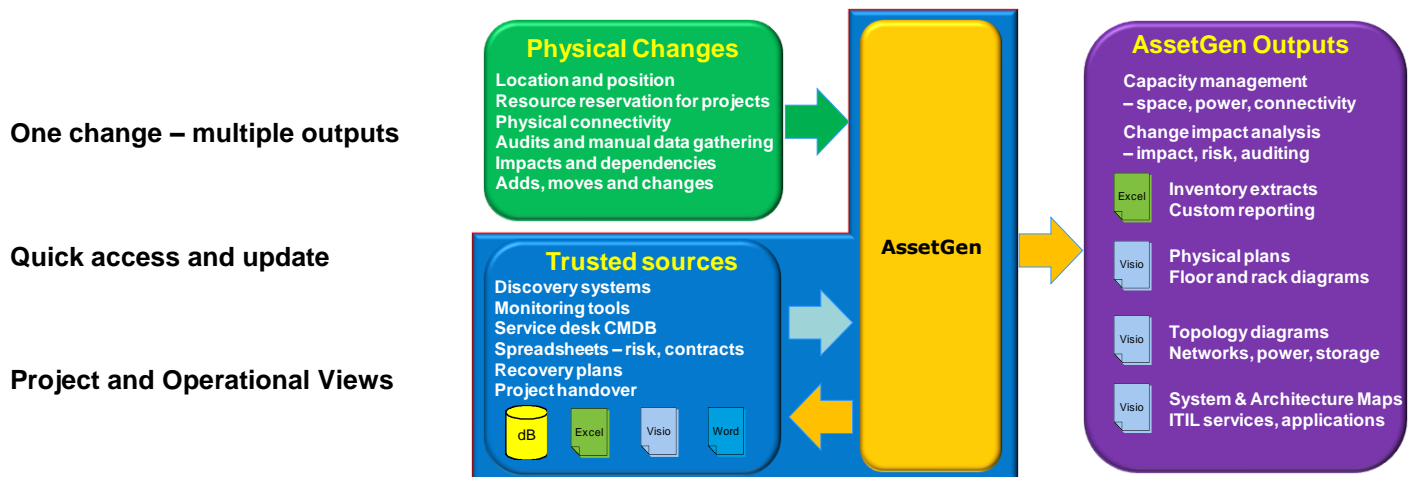


AssetGen IT Infrastructure Management

Overview

The AssetGen range enables project and operational teams to document technical and service infrastructures, greatly reducing their workload and change risks. Available in both desktop and multi-user server versions, AssetGen typically replaces multiple spreadsheets and uncoordinated Visio diagrams and greatly reduces the workload of managing changes. AssetGen products combine the power of a SQL database with web and desktop clients plus Visio visualisation. In one system we can document servers, networks, applications, power, cabling, business services and systems - providing a reference source to support infrastructure change projects and operational management.



The diagram shows how AssetGen can re-use existing data from trusted sources and physical change updates to produce multiple outputs. A change to a server only needs a single update to effect changes to capacity, risk, inventory and various Visio diagrams.

AssetGen Connect Professional – Physical Infrastructure Management

Connect Professional is designed to manage the physical aspects of infrastructure and can support data centres, networks, cabling, office buildings, etc. It combines hardware inventory with positioning and connectivity so the location of any hardware component can be easily found, as well as dependencies and single points of failure. AssetGen Connect Professional also automates the production of Visio diagrams of floor plans, racks, networks and architecture views.

AssetGen SysMap Professional – System and Service Mapping

Understanding the dependencies between hardware, applications and business services is the focus of SysMap Professional. It helps to identify the risks of single and multiple changes and produces Visio service maps for project and operations. SysMap also links with Connect so the impact of infrastructure changes (network, power, re-boot) on business services can be quickly identified.
